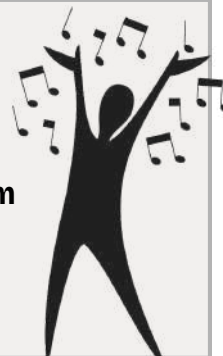

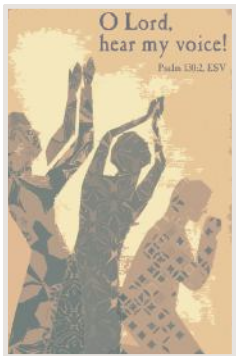

Solar project loan balance \$90,000, to be paid upon receipt of tax credits.

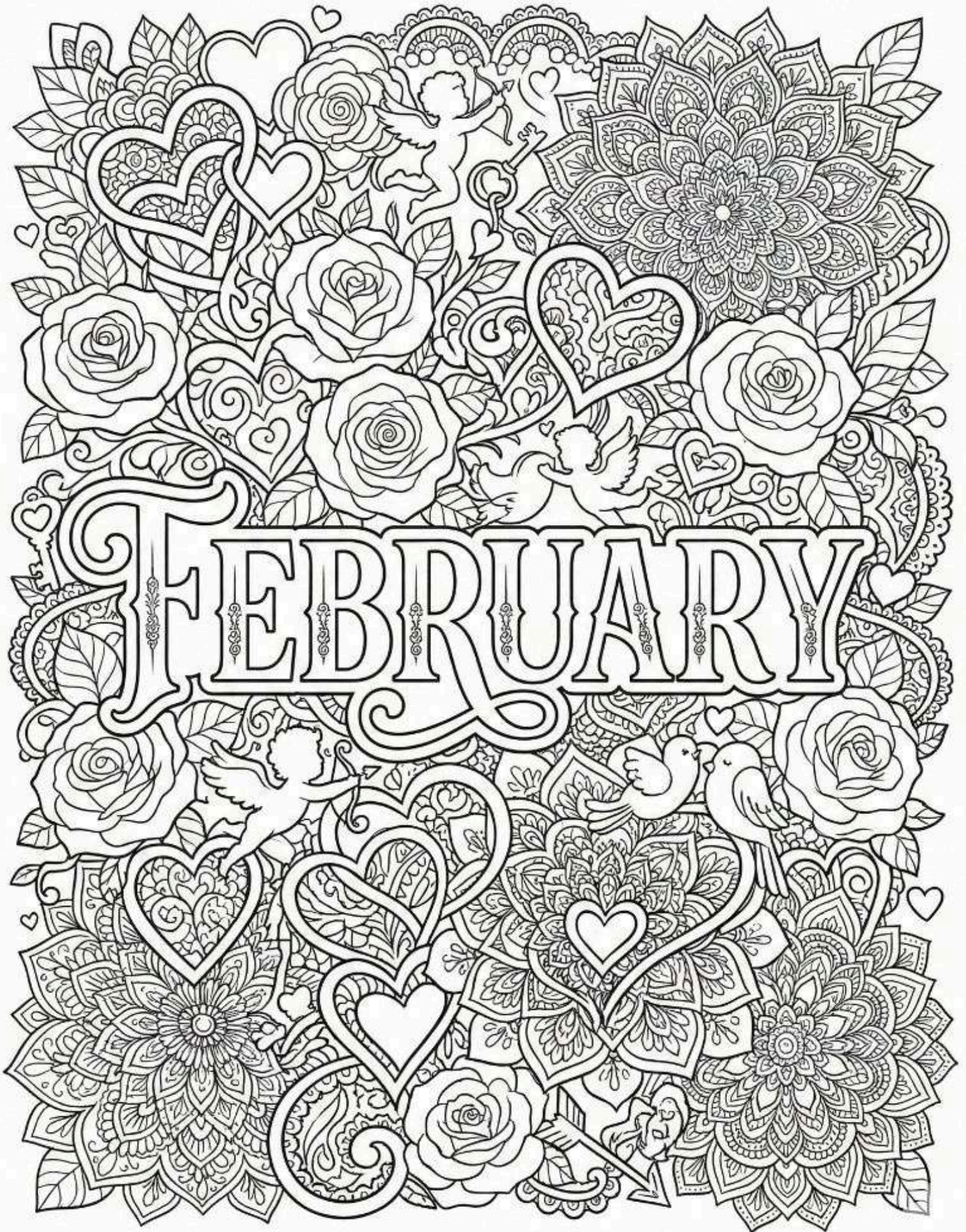
During December:

- The balance of the Monthly Emphasis Fund at the end of December 2025 was \$49.17 - School Supplies.
- The December Monthly Emphasis was OLLC People in a Pickle. A total of \$2,234.68 was given to the PIAP fund
- Local Benevolence for the Fourth Quarter totals about \$802.21. In December \$400 was allocated to the International Institute in St. Louis. The remainder (\$402.21) will be allocated in January.

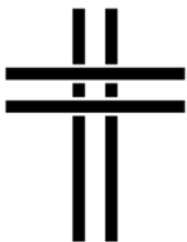
